Capital Planning Committee Meeting - November 7, 2019

Members present - Jay Byer, Norm Round, Matt O'Brien, and Henry Marshall Others present - Andrew Jenrich and Amy Fahey

- 1. Meeting called to order at 7:16pm by Jay Byer
- 2. Review and discuss Capital requests by Taft Public Library:
 - Discussed 25k feasibility study funds pending for rectory to find limitations of current building and possible renovation or demolition. This is at top of list.
 - Parking lot is striped and marked but a resurfacing was never done when the library opened. Needs to be resurfaced and marked/striped. About \$18,000-\$25,000.
 (Committee could only make recommendation if estimate above \$25,000)

Other items discussed under \$25,000:

- Discussed new circulation and patron computers totaling \$13,500-\$16,000, and suggested this should be in operating budget. Jay reminded Andrew that we can only make recommendations on items more than \$25,000.
- Vinyl fencing around grass area in front of rectory
- Sign and spotlight replacement (no cost yet) but going through Signs Plus. Sign currently only a couple years old but might want to replace with programmable LED sign.
- Committee concluded that none of the capital requests fall into the Capital Planning Committee's jurisdiction besides perhaps the paving project (dependent on the quote).
- 3. Motion to approve minutes from October 17, 2019 at 7:50pm by Jay, seconded by Henry, and approved unanimously
- 4. Reviewed and discussed Capital requests submitted by Senior Center
- 5. Discussed setting up meeting with economic development committee so we can be on the same page regarding town's revenue and expenses (capital needs).
- 6. Discussed systemizing a policy for requesting capital needs by departments including the possibility of creating a form linked to the capital planning committee's page on the Town of Mendon's website.
- 7. For next meeting on November 26, 2019:
 - Henry will create and update an excel sheet to keep track of capital needs by department which will be used in the later stage of prioritizing requests.
 - Jay will work on form for website for departments to submit capital needs.
 - Review water commission and parks department capital needs
- 8. Community comments none
- 9. Motion to adjourn at 8:10pm by Henry, seconded by Norm, approved unanimously.
