Tips for a Successful Yard Sale

1. Organize items into groups and ensure everything is clean.
2. Label every item with a price and be ready to negotiate.
3. Keep plenty of small change handy in a secure fanny pack or box.
4. Recycle grocery bags for customer convenience.
5. Keep pets indoors during the sale.
6. Be honest about item condition—transparency builds trust.
7. Include all items—it might be someone else's treasure!
8. Prepackaged food or bottled/canned drinks are acceptable if selling snacks.
9. Politely refuse early birds to avoid distractions before the official start time.
10. Plan ahead for unsold items, whether for donation or another use.
